



PRM Boosters Meeting Notes November 5, 2020

1. Kudos – Marissa Albright

- Brad Hoekzema and Todd Gailer for being soccer coordinators and running three soccer clinics this fall
- Soccer clinics went SO well! Lots of positive feedback from multiple families (via email) about how great this opportunity was for their kids.
 - Do we have take-aways from this success that we can use going forward?
 - Spring? Back to school time in August?
- PRM families for donating \$2500 to Boosters which was given directly to classroom teachers (teacher grants- Boosters and Foundation donated money to PTO to allocate to staff)

2. CPS Athletics Report – Marissa Albright and Allie Goodman

- CPS wants to allow access to the elementary gyms again starting on December 1st
- CPS currently wants elementary sports to have kids maintain teams within their current A/B cohorts
- 10 kids per team in the gym at a time, 20 kids maximum
 - Two teams at a time with divider put down

 - Meet on November 19th to make basketball decision
