4. PD Plan (2 min)

Suicide Prevention - Support on extreme behaviors - How can we talk to kids when kids are saying things to other kids. Kids are saying things like, "I want to die" so that they can get out of the class. At this point the District has taken stance that any child that makes that statement in any way, regardless if we think it is playing or not. How can we educate the peers on the right words to say when their students are doing things like self-harm or are saying things at home on social media or apps. 9-12 students are having emotional meltdowns, how can we reach out to a child that is so angry that they could hurt themselves but aren't necessarily saying those words. More training on de-escalating students' behaviors. Melissa - ask district if there are resources other than the CPI training.

9-12 needs to research and come back with a program or a person that can provide these specific trainings. Angela - 9-12 touch base with Sarah Lofquist about strategies that were taught to her through Children's Home.

5. Staffing/Budget Deadlines/Equity Allocation

Follow up from previous meeting presenting information from teams (45 min)

Update on staffing: ESL, Gifted, Foreign Language, Social worker, ISS. Custodian and Food service will be put back in building budget. What do we want that 4th PAM and the .5 PAM

9-12 team talked about having a 4th grade only classroom. 9-12 team is going back to team to vote on 12/6.

9-12/6-9/3-6: 4th PAM being a media specialist. Alia and ShaDonn will try and find out the specific title so that it is a licensed teacher.

Gifted: .5 gifted specialist/.5 technology - District and state are not in agreement over the qualifications for a full time gifted specialist. This will stay the same for 2019/2020 school year.

Technology Coordinator: Does not exist in district, so it was slated as assistant community coordinator. Position will not be there for 2019/2020 it will become the media specialist.

Job Description needed for the .5 gifted/.5 technology specialist.

6-9 is asking for another reading specialist and a mindfulness person come into the class to teach students not teachers.

3-6 is asking for 2 paras to cover full day, day-care and cover absences and help with any intervention programs. That will get rid of the 2, 3-hour nap aides. This will eliminate the need to take paras from upstairs. In the morning the 2 paras will be preparing the full day spaces for pre-k. In the morning the 2 Paras can provide interventions. Positions would assist with lunch.

9-12 5 Full-Time Teacher Tutors, 2 for math, 2 for ELA, 1 for intervention

Get information back by 12/19 and we will decide on budgeting out money and places. Final budgets by March.
