This morning, the Cincinnati Board of Education received an update on the [District's Safety Plan for Reopening Schools](#). We are committed to educating our students in as safe an environment as possible. As a result, the plan addresses all of the Considerations for Schools outlined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention: Behaviors that Reduce Spread, Maintaining Healthy Environments, Maintaining Healthy Operations and Preparing for When Someone Gets Sick. It paints a picture of what PRM will look like for students and staff in the fall.

Please take a moment to [review the plan](#) to see all the strategies we'll use to keep our students and staff safe. Other important topics covered during the meeting:

- The CPS administration is committed to using data and being flexible throughout the year. We are prepared to move to a fully remote learning model should conditions warrant. Similarly, the district currently is prepared to increase in-person learning should community and school health data suggest this would be safe.
- The district's preschool classrooms and specialized classrooms for students with disabilities will plan to operate with in-person instruction five days per week. Due to low per-classroom numbers, these groups will be able to maintain the six-foot social distancing recommendation.

The district will be sending important information to families over the coming weeks. This will include an update on safety protocols and logistics that will be both emailed and mailed to homes in the next several days.
