Greetings PRM Families,

On August 3, Cincinnati Public Schools decided to move to distance learning for the first five weeks of the 2020-21 school year for all grades — preschool to 12th grades. The current rate of COVID-19 transmission within our community is too high to provide a safe in-person learning environment.

School will start on August 24.

CPS will provide an update on the health data the week of September 14, and, if there is a sustained improvement, we plan to return to a blended-learning model the week of September 28.

Student Orientation — Our school team is working to develop a robust orientation for our students. The specific date, times, and location will be shared in future correspondence.

Parent Orientation — A parent orientation is also being developed. We will share more information soon.

Technology Distribution — Cincinnati Public Schools is expanding two programs aimed at making sure **all CPS students have computers and internet access** to do school work at home for the 2020–21 school year.

CPS' **preschool students and first-graders** will receive iPads starting August 24. And device distribution that began in July to give computers to students in grades 2-12 will continue.

And, the Connect Our Students program with Cincinnati Bell to provide free internet in homes, which began in July for students in five schools, is being expanded faster than expected **to include all CPS schools**. Cincinnati Bell will begin contacting all CPS families starting August 3 to offer the free Internet hookup.

Student Device Distribution

CPS' preschool students, kindergarteners and first-graders will receive iPads starting August 24.

The device distribution program began in July originally with iPads and laptops for students in grades 2–12, while plans were worked out to provide iPads to the youngest students.

All PRM students in grades 2 – 6 are to pick up a device from PRM on August 17th and 18th! Students will pick up devices at the front lobby entrances of their schools on specific distribution days between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

When you arrive, pull into the school's front driveway, and a CPS technician will give instructions. Parents may pick up devices without the student present. (Please note they do need to pick them up at the school where the student is attending school in the fall.)

Families can arrange for a family member or friend to pick up the device. They would just need the student's name and date of birth. However, make-up days to pick up devices will be scheduled and announced, as well as via robocalls to the families who missed their assigned days.

Health and safety guidelines from the federal Centers for Disease Control will be followed during distribution, including six-foot distancing and wearing masks to help prevent the spread of germs. For More Information, All PRM students in grades 2 – 6 are to pick up a device from PRM on August 17th and 18th!

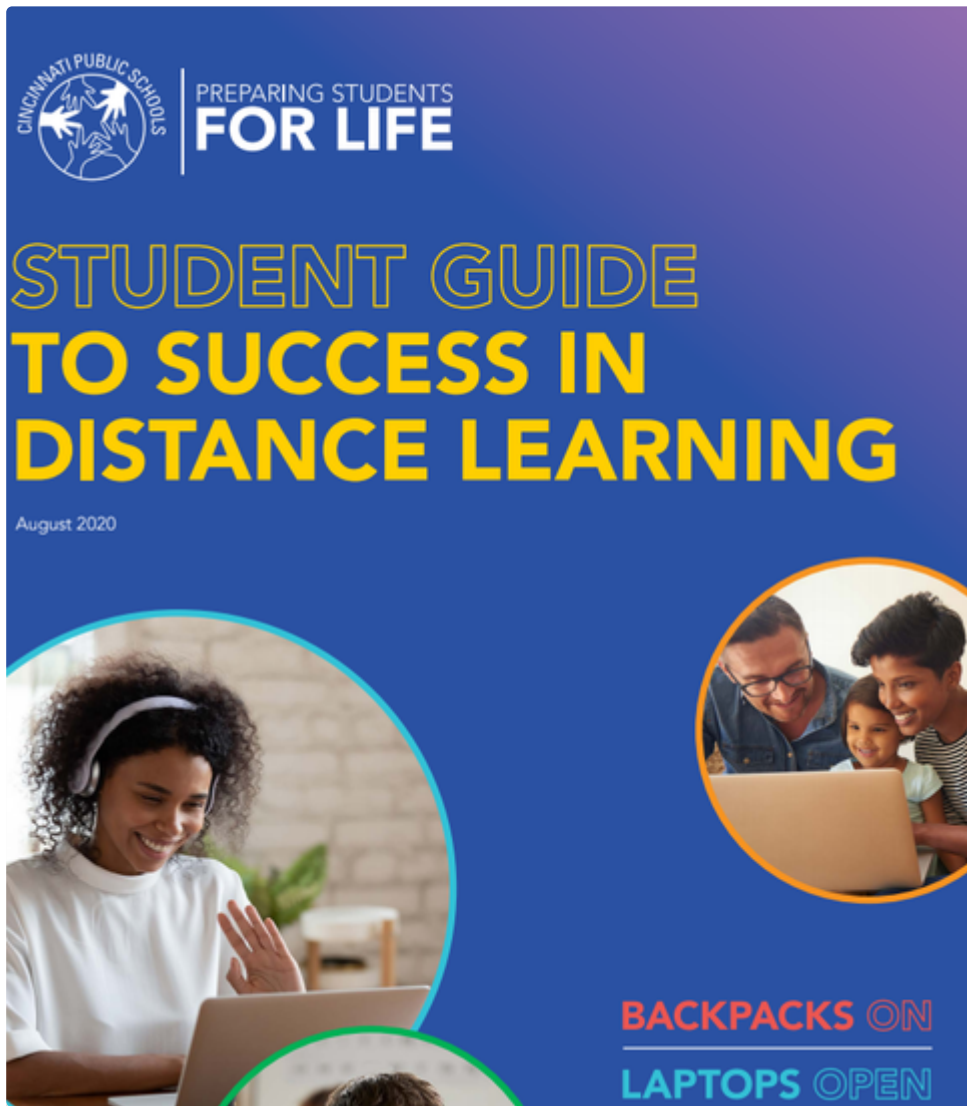

Sample Remote Learning Schedule

Zearn Information

Zearn Math is an online program that the school has purchased to provide students with math reinforcement at school and home. The digital lessons are approximately 30 minutes each. In most classes students are expected to complete 4 lessons a week. The amazing component of the Zearn program is that students are provided with a guided lesson by a "Zearn digital teacher", prior to any independent practice. This occurs during each lesson!!!! To sum up students have access to Zearn at home by using the following steps to log in:

1. Go to the Clever site <https://clever.com/>
2. Log in using their Google Usernames and Passwords
3. Click on the yellow Zearn box and they are in.

Most students know their usernames and passwords, however you can ask the teachers for them if they don't remember.
