 - Emma wrote and applied for grant and is meeting with Deb and Marissa
 Albright (girl scout troop leaders) to discuss ideas

 - Treasurer recommends payment; funds exist and will be paid to Imago
- Initiatives for the 2021-2022 school year
 - Discussions continuing on Equity as our focus for the next two school years
 - Can be a wide focus that narrows over time as needs are unveiled
 - CPS District is also putting focus on this topic
 - Need to contact Ms. Simpson to learn of district wide initiatives and to hear her opinion on where there might be equity gaps
 - Ask Ms. Simpson about grade level requests and ideas to move this forward
 - o Initial conversations to include Sara B., Missy K., Birgit H., Marissa R., Amanda B., and Jasmine R.
 - Sara Bourgeois motions to approve Equity as our new initiative for the next two school years, Tami Kauffman seconds, motion passes

 - o Current benefits chart needs updated for the 2021-2022 school year
 - o Businesses to approach
 - Dr. Katie Blomer should be asked to renew for the third consecutive year, she is currently a two-year supporter of PRM
 - Nicole Webb going next week, Allie Goodman also has connection and can follow up in August
 - As a foundation we need to ask more new businesses to support us
 - Everyone should keep this in mind when working with local businesses

Treasurer's Report

- May financial reports sent by Tami Kauffman via email on June 8th
 - Bank statements were also attached to email bank statements were reviewed by Missy Kyrlach and Sara Bourgeois
- 2021-2022 Budget
 - Current budget ends on June 30th and new budget begins July 1st, 2021
 - o Link in the agenda for the proposed budget sent by Tami Kauffman on June 4th
 - This year Raised \$48,000, Spent \$43,000 (maintained budget goal)
 - Allows us to pay \$4,000 to Imago to complete contract
 - Next year (2021-2022) \$66,000 in the budget to spend
 - \$56,000 planned expenditures which leaves \$10,000 to be spent on initiatives for the upcoming school year
 - o Lauren Posta motions to approve the 2021-2022 school year, Jackie Bonfield seconds. Budget passes unanimously.

Grants Reports

- Grants Report sent by Marianne Quellhorst via email on June 8th
 - o Dollar General Youth Literacy Grant (Grant for up to \$4000)
 - Marianne working with Marcy Berns (current PRM reading specialist) to transition this information to Kaitlyn Metersky who is taking over that position
 - Orton Gilligham sound decks and decodable texts
 - o Greater Cincinnati Foundation Learning Links Program
 - Submitted two applications (both for up to \$1250)
 - Rubik's Cube grant written Jackie Bonfield champion
 - Music Play in the Outdoor Area Emma Massie submitted grant
 - o Interactive music and stage area
 - Stage to cover previous three sisters beds
 - Music features with support from Ms. Maria
 - Deb Chambless and Marissa Albright's girl scout troop to support this project
 - Doing this with Allison McGrath in mind and considering dedication

 - Tie Dye in front Amy and Ben Gardner to champion
 - Food trucks in front circle
 - Partner tables out back, with uniform exchange and spiritwear
 - Will need foundation members to staff an information table
 - Windows of time will be given for supply drop off inside the school
 - Allie Goodman and Erin Spears to coordinate the 1st Day School Supplies drop off and fundraiser
 - o Staff Back to School Breakfast will provide food however best advised
 - o Million Fathers March First day of school, being championed by Jason Chambless

 - Silent Auction Nicole Webb to champion with help from new members
 - Date for hosting can be flexible
 - Classroom projects bring in lots of money and staff needs time to create
 - Cody Walter to build 6th grade canoe to donate
 - Read-A-Thon Moving back to fall Erin Spears and Allie Goodman to champion
 - Conversation around Scholastic vs. Joseph Beth Bookfair Fundraiser
 - Scholastic has more inexpensive options
 - Joseph Beth is more expensive but offers adult book options as well as children's books and more quality book options

- Book Exchange can be centered around Read-a-thon/Fall Festival beginning/middle of October
 - Including donations from the PR library and other partnerships
- Joseph Beth Book Fair Fundraiser can happen in the spring around Read Across America Day in partnership with Ms. Simpson
- Flower Sale March through May Lindsey Felder to champion
 - Winter Poinsettias possibility in November/December
- o Restaurants Supporting PRM Allie Goodman currently championing
 - Marissa Beck would be interested in helping make connections (she works at Rhinegiest) – Marissa Rowley to make connections
- Buddy Cards Nicole Webb to champion (card sell best after spring break)
- o Mike's Car Wash Nicole Webb to champion attempting to sell coupons in late fall

- Update on Summer Learning cash flow to fund Summer Scholars 2021

 - \$37,000 funneling through Foundation to make Summer Scholars a reality
 - Foundation to pay vendors on behalf of CPS and then to submit receipts for reimbursement to be received within 60 days for payback
