3. Treasurer's Report

- a. February financial reports were sent by Meredith Haluga via email on March 14th
 - i. Foundation Bank statements were emailed—statements were reviewed and signed off on by Allie Goodman and Erin Spears
 - ii. Booster Bank statements were also reviewed– statements were reviewed by Marissa Albright and Colleen Arbuckle
- b. There are many companies who will do matching donations, has this or can this be advertised to the greater PRM community?
- c. Insurance, accountant and AMS were all paid this month!
- d. Network for Good BIG changes
 - i. One of the current changes that was made to their platform is that we can no longer use multiple ticketing for PRM events
 - 1. The website is also capable of some of this same work but it takes more time and isn't nearly as user friendly
 - ii. Can our events calendar do this work?
 - iii. \$2200 paid annually to Network for Good
 - iv. Additional \$500 to use multiple tickets at events
 - 1. Flower sales (mums, poinsettas, spring flowers)
 - 2. Flamingos have multiple tickets
 - 3. Bricks, Buddy cards, etc.

4. Current Fundraiser-Read-a-thon

- a. This year's excitement:
 - i. Total minutes read = 60,134
 - ii. Total readers = 264

- iii. Total readers who read all 7 days = 237 (last year we ordered 131 shirts for reference an increase of 81%)
- iv. Met our \$10,000 goal
- b. Next Year, year 5 ideas:
 - i. Read-a-thon Bracket for 16 books to find our favorite
 - ii. Kid artwork design the spine of a book
 - iii. Kid made booklet to doodle about their reading
 - iv. Donate a shirt to a teacher
