      - 1. Include Deb Chambless and Chris Clements in conversation to make decisions
  - c. Dollar General Grant approved for \$3000
    - i. \$3904 applied for OG sound decks and decodable texts.
      - 1. It is not likely that the additional money will be needed-Marianne to confirm with PRM staff
- 6. Initiative Equity
  - a. The PRM Equity Group will be meeting virtually and in person tomorrow evening (11/18/21), all are welcome and encouraged to attend.
    - i. Oneya Okwabi presenting on Critical Race Theory
- 7. Old Business
  - a. American Montessori Society
    - Tami Kauffman presenting information on membership benefits and costs from research done with speaking to Ms. Simpson, Sarah Loftquist and the AM Society itself
      - 1. \$2500 for annual membership from July to June
        - a. January is when memberships possibly become pro-rated
      - 2. Individual benefits need to be purchased by or for each Montessori accredited teacher \$92 for 20 certified teachers which is \$1840
        - a. CPS is willing to pay this cost for this year only

- b. Benefits include- discount for annual conference in March, online resources for teachers, assist with accreditation happening in January 2023
- c. In hopes of adopting "Montessori curriculum and accreditation"
- ii. Conversation around this topic with questions about how long will these payments be needed, how likely is PRM to receive
- iii. Amanda Bennett moves to make a motion that the PRM Foundation pays up to \$2500 for this year's AMS membership, Marissa Albright seconds and motion passes unanimously
- b. Garden-Upcoming Work Days

  - ii. Garden Plots- will be sold to previous owners first and then offered up to others starting in early February
  - iii. Fence team needs to be created-grant money exists
